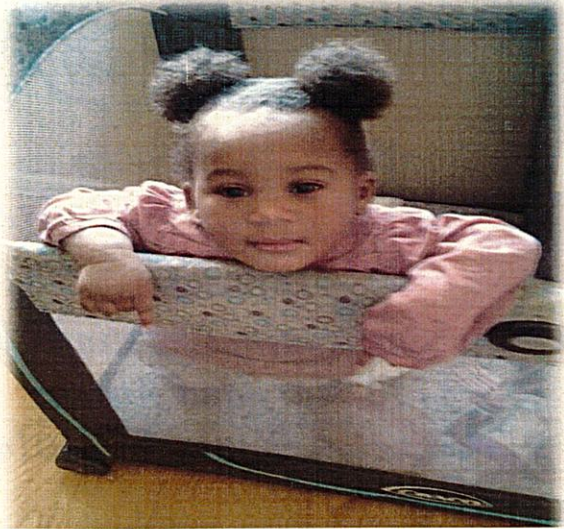

Kerteris Glover was born September 7, 1983 to Shelia Glover and Curtis Johnson.

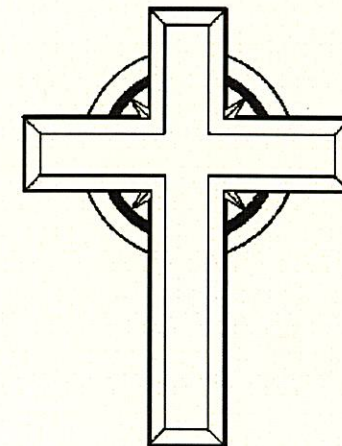
