

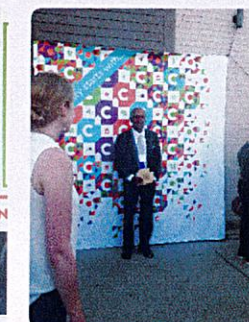
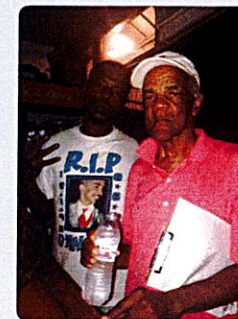
Obituary

David Housley, 74, of Covington Ky, passed away on July 24th, 2023. He was born September 12, 1948 to Lena and Clifton Housley. David graduated from Holmes High School in 1966. He was presented the Great Neighbor & Heart of the Community awards by The Center of Great Neighborhoods, received an Appreciation Award for Community Service by the OASIS of Covington, Desert of Ky and honored by the City of Covington at the 31st Annual Old Timers Festival with the dedication of the new shelter that bears his name, David Housley Pavilion.

David was preceded in death by his parents Lena and Clifton Housley, siblings Charles, Clifford, William, Rosetta, Nathaniel, Barbara, Melvin, Howard and son Joseph. He leaves to cherish his memory, children, Isiah and Angela and siblings, Allen, Lois, Theodore, Marie and Jessie.
