

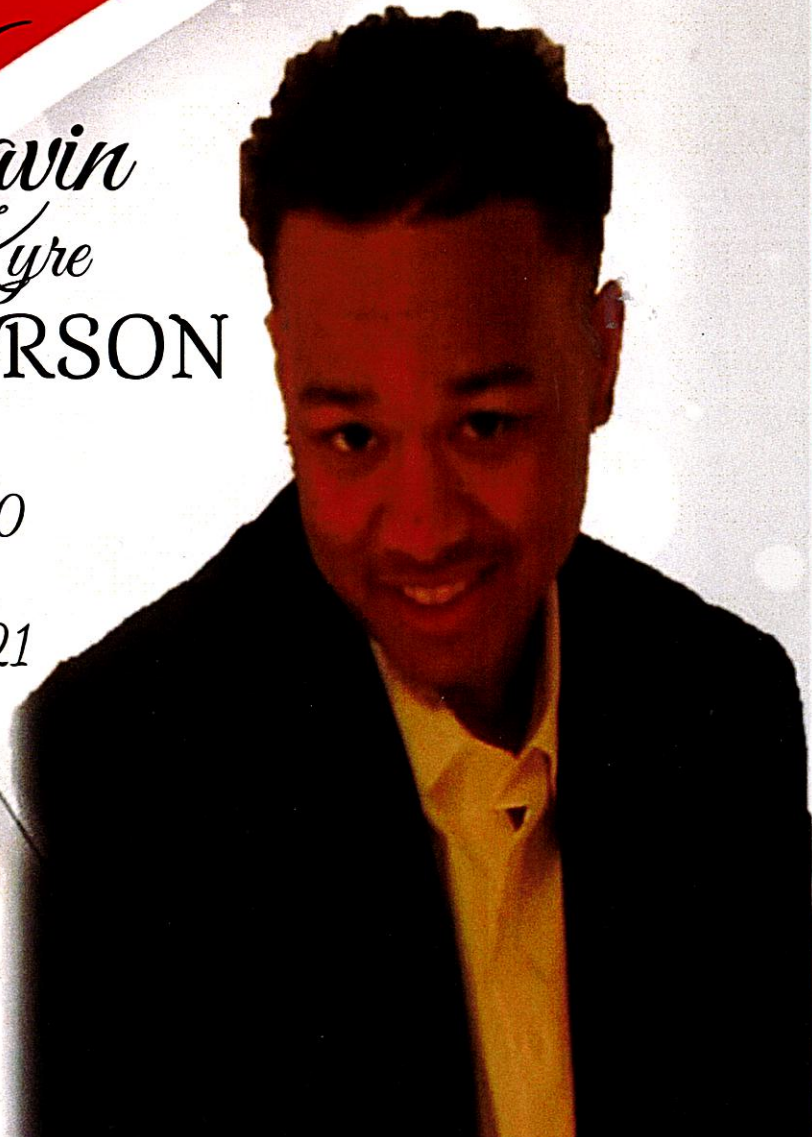

but the truth still remains.

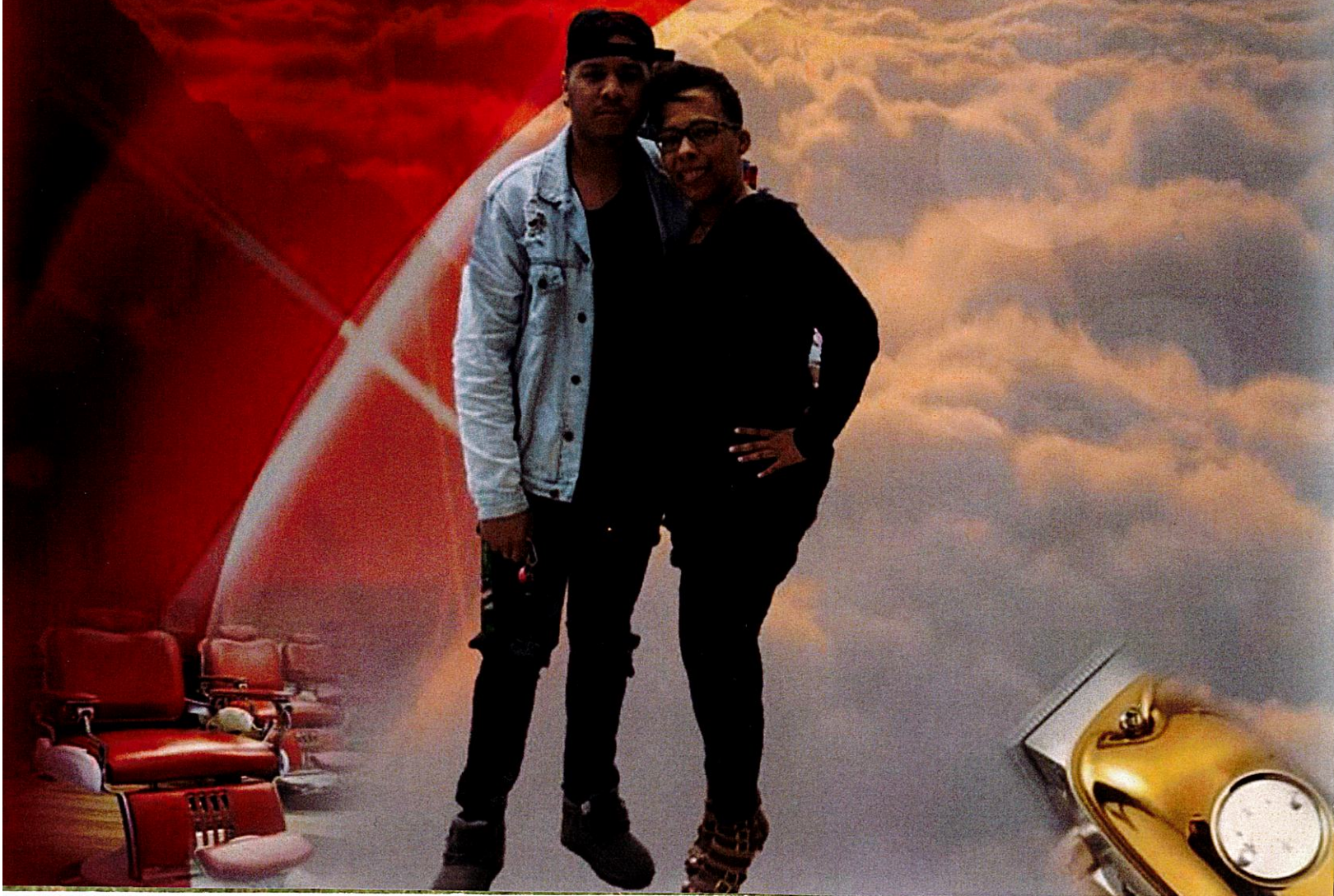
"I got this" is what you always said and Staying Focused is what

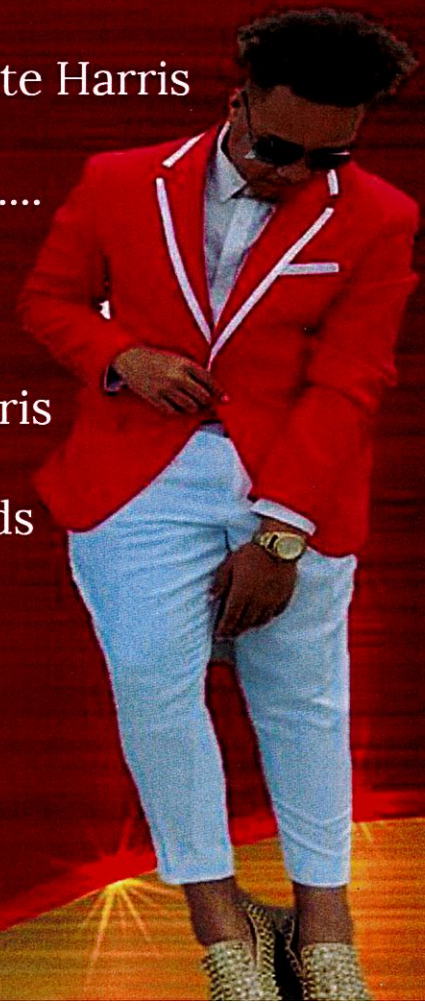

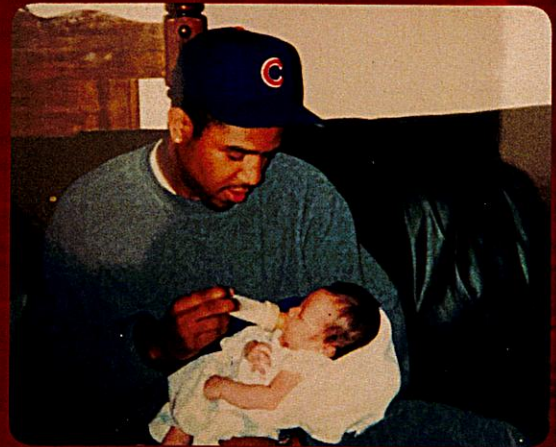
